I understand that this feasibility study is a high priority need to address a critical two-lane gap and many severe and fatal crashes on a trunk highway route providing east-west regional connection between US Highways 10 and 169 and further to I-35. On behalf of the City of Milaca, I am pleased to support the Foley to Mora Highway 23 Feasibility Study for consideration of funding in the 2023 Community Project Funding solicitation. We understand that this feasibility study is a high priority need to address a critical two-lane gap and many severe and fatal crashes on a trunk highway route providing east-west regional connection between US Highways 10 and 169 and further to I-35. Also, those funds will be used to further develop priority projects identified by the study.

This study area has seen seventeen fatal and twelve serious injury crashes in the last ten years and the study area carries up to 12,000 vehicles per day including 1,100 heavy commercial freight vehicles. Our region's economy is heavily supported by industries that rely on the transportation of physical goods to support their operations. These freight-related industries employ nearly thirty-five percent of our region's workforce. Manufacturing, retail trade, and construction place high demand on this segment of Highway 23 as well as access for our residents to reach jobs and services.

Due to the safety and mobility concerns related to this critical two-lane gap on Highway 23, City of Milaca, has recognized the need for improvements. This is an important investment to provide safety and mobility improvements along Highway 23, the second longest state transportation system traveling from Sioux Falls, South Dakota to Duluth, Minnesota and Superior, Wisconsin.

For the reasons above, City of Milaca, endorses the Foley to Mora Highway 23 Feasibility Study and urges decisions makers to prioritize it for funding.
